



HowTo backup a jetNEXUS Traffic Manager

Stages:

- Backup the configuration
- Backup the license(s)
- Note down networking and snmp settings

Backup the Configuration:

There are two ways to do this. The first is to export the configuration that is currently running. The second is to download a backup that is stored on the machine.

Backup the configuration:

1. Browse to the web interface. Go to "Services > Config Summary "
2. Then click on "Export"
3. This will tar up the configuration ready to be put back on.

Create and Backup A Backup File:

1. Browse to the web interface Go to : System > Backups
2. Type in the name of the new backup to create in the Name box. Type a description in the box below to make a note of why you are backing up.
3. Click Save.
4. To save the backup you just created click it in the list at the top of the page.
5. Scroll to the bottom of the details page that has appeared and click export
6. Save it.

Backup the Licenses

This involves copying the file from the appropriate location on the machine using scp. We recommend using WinSCP. This can be downloaded from <http://winscp.net/>

1. Open WinSCP and connect to the Traffic Manager. Go to: /opt/zeus/zxtm-4.2/conf/licensekeys
2. Select all the files in that location and copy them to the local machine.

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Backup the Networking and SNMP Settings

At the moment these are not backed up with the backup made earlier. These need to be noted by hand. This includes gateways, routes and network addresses.

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
